

## **Funerals:** For the Living or the Dead?

A sophistry is something that sounds wise, but when looked at more closely is revealed to be foolish or wrong. One such sophistry that was hatched in the 1970's and sadly continues to our times is: "Funerals are for the living." This was during a period of time when for many (including many clergy), psychology supplanted religion and faith for answering the most profound questions of our existence. God was pushed to the side. The wisdom of the Scriptures was ignored, all in favor of us answering our most vexing questions by looking at ourselves.

Any convincing lie has to have a certain element of truth, or it will be disregarded as rubbish. Do funerals help the living? Of course. When we attend vigil (wake) services, funeral Masses, and burial rituals, we are forced to confront the death of a friend or loved one. We say our goodbyes, share memories with friends, and life goes on.

But as Catholics we know that this is just part of the bigger picture. What about the eternal soul of the deceased? In many conversations we hear things like, "Grandma is with Jesus now" or "Carl has gone to heaven." Really? Are we that sure? If we are so sure that going to heaven is just part of the package deal when we die, they why mourn the dead? Why have funerals for them? If they are in heaven, we have only to dispose of their body and get on with our day.

In fact we know that very few of us die in a perfect state of grace ready to behold the face of God in heaven. For this reason, we pray for our dead. Make no mistake about it, funerals, while consoling the living, are for the benefit of the eternal souls of the deceased.

For this reason, we attend funeral vigil services, funeral Masses, have Masses said for the repose of the souls of the deceased, and make visits to the cemetery to pray for the dead. We need to keep this practices alive by taking our children to the funeral home for a wake service and teaching them to pray for the dead by remembering them at Mass. We will not know until the Judgment Day how many souls we helped out of purgatory with our prayers. We may be aghast at how many languished in purgatory longer than necessary because we were told and believed that "Funerals are for the living."



## **Plenary Indulgences**

Plenary Indulgences for All Souls Week and the Month of November.

**Visiting a Cemetery**: An indulgence, applicable only to the Souls in Purgatory, is granted to the faithful, who devoutly visit a cemetery and pray, even if only mentally, for the departed. Typically, the indulgence is plenary each day from Nov. 1-8; on other days of the year, it is only a partial indulgence.

Visiting a Church on Nov. 2: A plenary indulgence, applicable only to the Souls in Purgatory, is granted to the faithful, who on the day dedicated to the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed [Nov. 2 {as well as on the Sunday preceding or following, and on All Saints' Day}] piously visit a church. In visiting the church, it is required that one Our Father and the Creed be recited.

Indulgence Requirements: To acquire a plenary indulgence, it is necessary also to fulfill the following three conditions: sacramental Confession, Eucharistic communion, and prayer for the intention of the Holy Father while being detached from sin. It is appropriate that the sacramental Confession and especially Holy Communion and the prayer for the Pope's intentions take place on the same day that the indulgenced work is performed; but it is sufficient that these sacred rites and prayers be carried out within several days (about 20) before or after the indulgenced act. One sacramental Confession suffices for several plenary indulgences, but a separate Holy Communion and a separate prayer for the Holy Father's intentions are required for each plenary indulgence.

The condition of praying for the intention of the Holy Father is fully satisfied by reciting one Our Father and one Hail Mary. A plenary indulgence can be acquired only once in the course of the day.

~ Lord Jesus, lovingly welcome into Your presence my deceased family, relatives and friends who have completed their journey on this earth, and have gone to their rest in the hope of rejoicing with you forever in heaven.

Source of all life and love, in Your infinite mercy, look favorably upon their goodness, and forgive any sins they may have committed, so they may enjoy for all eternity the great rewards You have promised to those who believe in You. Amen.

V. Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord.

**R**. And let the perpetual light shine upon them. May the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen.
